Green 4 5 FILE/29 11/29/16 11:46:25 Larry Crane Pulaski Circuit Clerk 6 ORDINANCE 7 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF 9 PULASKI, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED: 10 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING OF A VOLUNTARY TAX OF FIVE 11 12 DOLLARS (\$5) FOR THE SUPPORT OF PULASKI COUNTY'S EFFORTS TO MANAGE 13 ITS POPULATION OF DOMESTIC PETS AND STRAY DOMESTIC ANIMALS AND 14 FOR OTHER PURPOSES. 15 16 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of Pulaski County residents to manage the population of 17 18 domestic animals and pets, especially the population of stray animals; 19 WHEREAS, having limited resources to dedicate to said purpose, Pulaski County must rely upon 20 21 the generosity of its tax-payer for support through a voluntary tax. 22 23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF PULASKI 24 COUNTY, ARKANSAS: 25 26 27 Article 1: There is hereby levied a voluntary tax of five dollars (\$5) billed in the calendar year 2017 and subsequent years to appear on bills for collection of personal property subject to taxation 28 29 within Pulaski County. 30 31 The voluntary tax shall be set forth as a "Voluntary Animal Control Spay/Neuter Tax" to be paid by the property owner on his or her own volition. The property tax statement sent 32 to the property owners by Pulaski County shall specify this tax as voluntary. 33 34 35 Article 3: All monies collected from this voluntary tax shall be set aside in a fund to be 36 designated the "County Animal Control Spay/Neuter Fund" and shall be appropriated by the 37 Pulaski County Quorum Court for animal population control and spay or neuter services provided by Pulaski County Animal Control either directly or indirectly through private entities under 38 39 contract with Pulaski County. 40 This voluntary five dollar (\$5) tax shall be a continuing levy until altered or 41 Article 4. 42 abolished by the Pulaski County Quorum Court.
